

21st Century Scholarship

Do you have a child who is enrolled in 7th or 8th grade in a public or private school accredited by the Indiana Department of Education?

If the answer is YES, it's time to start thinking about college!!

What is 21st Century Scholarship?

It is an early-college promise program designed to help ensure that every Hoosier student can afford the opportunity provided by a college education. Today, eligible students who maintain the Scholar Pledge to excellence in school and life receive a scholarship for up to four years of up to 100% tuition at an eligible Indiana college or university after they graduate from high school.

What does the 21st Century Scholarship cover?

At in-state, public two-year and four-year colleges, the 21st Century Scholarship covers up to 100 percent of tuition and some regularly assessed fees, such as technology, student-activity and health-services fees. The scholarship pays part of the tuition at private or independent colleges and approved for-profit specialty or proprietary schools.

Is my child eligible for 21st Century Scholars?

To be eligible for 21st Century Scholars, students must:

- Be an Indiana resident
- Be enrolled in 7th or 8th grade at an Indiana public or private school accredited by the Indiana Department of Education
- Be a US citizen or eligible non-citizen
- Be a member of a family that meets income eligibility guidelines.
- Note: A student in foster case does not need to meet this requirement.

How do I enroll in 21st Century Scholars?

Parents or guardians enrolling their child should go to ScholarTrack.In.gov and create a parent account. All applications to the 21st Century Scholars program must be submitted before June 30 of the child's 8th grade year.

- Parents or guardians will need the following to apply:
- Student Social Security number, date of birth and address
- Parent or guardian Social Security number or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number, if applicable
- Previous year gross income amounts for all members of the household
- A valid email address.
